Step by Step Setup Guide

Firefox:

Here's a step-by-step guide to set up OpenWeb.co.za's free USA-based proxy on Firefox:

Step 1: Open Firefox Preferences

- 1. Open Firefox on your computer.
- 2. Click the ******Menu****** icon (three horizontal lines) in the top-right corner of the Firefox window.
- 3. From the dropdown menu, select **Settings**.

Step 2: Access Proxy Settings

1. In the **Settings** menu, scroll down to the **Network Settings** section at the bottom of the page.

2. Click the **Settings** button next to **Network Settings**.

Step 3: Configure Proxy Settings

1. A window labeled **Connection Settings** will appear. In this window, choose **Manual proxy configuration**.

- 2. Enter the following details:
 - **HTTP Proxy:** `proxy1.openweb.co.za`

- **Port:** `808`

- 3. Enter the same details for the ****SSL** Proxy******:
 - **SSL Proxy (HTTPS):** `proxy1.openweb.co.za`
 - **Port:** `808`
- 4. If you want to configure the SOCKS5 proxy as well (optional):
 - Scroll to the **SOCKS Host** field and enter: `proxy1.openweb.co.za`
 - **Port:** `1080`
 - Select **SOCKS5**.

### Step 4: Bypass Local Connections (Optional)
```

1. If you don't want the proxy to be used for local connections, check the box that says **"Do not proxy for"** and enter `localhost, 127.0.0.1`.

Step 5: Save Settings

1. After entering all the proxy details, click ****OK**** to save the settings.

Step 6: Enter Authentication Details

- 1. When you start browsing, Firefox will prompt you to enter a username and password.
- 2. Enter the following credentials:
 - **Username:** `openweb`
 - **Password:** `Apple1526!!@`
- 3. Check the box **"Remember this password"** if you want Firefox to store it.

Step 7: Test the Proxy

1. Open a new tab and visit any website to test if the proxy is working correctly. If everything is configured properly, your connection should now be routed through OpenWeb.co.za's USA-based proxy.

Step-by-Step Guide to Setting Up OpenWeb.co.za's Free USA-Based Proxy on Chrome

Follow these steps to set up OpenWeb.co.za's USA-based proxy in Google Chrome:

Step 1: Open Chrome and Access Settings

- 1. Open **Google Chrome** on your computer.
- 2. In the upper right corner, click on the **three vertical dots** (Menu).
- 3. From the dropdown menu, select **Settings**.

Step 2: Navigate to System Settings

- 1. Scroll down and click on **"Advanced"** to expand additional settings.
- 2. Under the **System** section, click on **"Open your computer's proxy settings."**

Step 3: Access Proxy Settings

This will take you to your computer's network settings, where you can configure the proxy.

- 1. In **Windows**, the "Internet Properties" window should pop up.
- 2. If you're using a ******Mac******, it will direct you to your "Network" preferences.

Step 4: Configure the Proxy for Windows

- 1. In the ******Internet Properties****** window (Windows):
 - Click on the **Connections** tab.

- Click on **LAN settings**.

2. Under **LAN settings**, check the box for **"Use a proxy server for your LAN"**.

3. In the **Address** field, enter the proxy host: `proxy1.openweb.co.za`.

4. In the ****Port**** field, enter the HTTP/HTTPS port number: `808`.

5. Check the box for **"Bypass proxy server for local addresses"** if you want to bypass the proxy for local networks.

6. Click **OK**.

Step 5: Configure the Proxy for Mac

- 1. In the ****Network Preferences**** window (Mac):
 - Select the network connection you're using (e.g., **Wi-Fi** or **Ethernet**).
- Click **Advanced**.
- 2. Go to the **Proxies** tab.
- 3. Check **"Web Proxy (HTTP)"** and **"Secure Web Proxy (HTTPS)"**.
- 4. For both, enter the **proxy1.openweb.co.za** in the **Web Proxy Server** field.
- 5. Enter the **Port** as `808`.
- 6. Click **OK**.

Step 6: Enter Proxy Authentication Credentials

1. Once you apply the proxy settings, when you visit any webpage in Chrome, a prompt will appear asking for authentication.

- 2. Enter the **Username**: `openweb`.
- 3. Enter the **Password**: `Apple1526!!@`.
- 4. Click ******OK****** to save the authentication credentials.

Step 7: Verify the Proxy is Working

1. Open Chrome and visit a website to ensure your internet connection is working through the proxy.

2. You can visit a site like [WhatIsMyIP.com](https://www.whatismyip.com/) to confirm that your IP address has changed to reflect the USA-based proxy.
